MEMBERSHIP CODE OF CONDUCT

RLM Officers, Directors and Members shall:

- conduct their activities with honesty, integrity and professionalism
- not solicit another member for business.
- respect the privacy of other members and not provide their name to any third party without their permission
- provide full disclosure of all material information to RLN Officers in writing when there is any real or perceived conflict of interest whether it is a personal interest or a direct or indirect potential conflict, with any company applying to RLN
- hold in strict confidence any information arising from RLN whether verbal, at meetings, through electronic means, or in writing concerning the business and affairs of any other RLM Member or the business and affairs of any company that applies or provides information to RLN for consideration by the Network or the RLN Members.
- not criticize any RLN Officer, Director or Member nor refer to them in a disparaging manner.
- co-operate with any investigation by RLN of their conduct or of another RLN Member's conduct. Co-operation may include providing access to and copies of documents and answering questions relevant to an investigation, unless prevented from doing so by law.
- not, when acting in a professional capacity, discriminate or participate in discrimination against any person and shall be aware of the rights and obligations of the applicable Human Rights codes in the jurisdictions where such the RLN Member or an applicant to RLN conducts business.
- conduct their activities in full compliance with all federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. Conduct by an RLN Member that results in a violation of any criminal or civil code is unethical.
